Competitors do not have to be Members of the Association to compete in these classes.

No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.

Entries in these classes are confined to registered Ponies/Horses ridden by members of the BSJA in accordance with BSJA Rule 79. Rule 76.6 may be applied. Entries will be taken on the day.

Class 901 1.05m Open

For registered horses. Speed 350m per minute. Table Two Phase. Rule 286A.

Class 902 1.10m Open

For registered horses, table A7, speed 350m per minute. If 50 or more starters, two phase will apply (Rule 286A).

For registered horses in Grade C which have not won a total of £600. Rule 310, A7, height 1.20m maximum in first round, speed 350 m per minute. First three horses will qualify for the final, to be held at the Royal Highland Show, disregarding those already qualified, down to sixth place, provided that they jump clear in the first round. 1st rosette sponsored by Horse & Hound.
